
Press Release

The North Forest Independent School District Police Department is encouraging everyone to make crime prevention a priority due to recent burglarized of motor vehicles in the district. Crime Prevention is aimed at promoting initiatives that help make our communities safer places to live, work and visit by engaging and involving members of the community. North Forest ISD Police Department belief that an informed community is better equipped to protect itself, giving notice of incidents which occurred in our community.

Reporting crime is everyone's responsibility. If you see a crime being committed on or around district or are a victim of a crime, report it immediately. North Forest ISD Police Department is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week including holidays. When you report a crime, dispatch will send an available officer to your location. In addition, I have listed safety tips below that are friendly reminders:

- **PROGRAM EMERGENCY NUMBERS INTO YOUR PHONE** - Within the North Forest Independent School District we can respond to emergencies much faster than other local law enforcement. Emergency: 911, Emergency: 713-636-4319 and Non Emergency: (713) 633-2033.
- **REPORT SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY** - Criminals do not want to be seen or heard. For that reason they rarely commit crime in front of law enforcement officers. We rely on the community to contact us when suspicious persons or activities occur. We would much rather respond and not be needed than to not be called when something could have been prevented. Trust your instincts; if something does not feel right, it probably isn't.
- **SECURE PROPERTY AND LOCK YOUR DOORS** – Criminals often look for the path of least resistance; they will typically move onto another easier target if they encounter locked doors or property is not in plain sight.
